As you know, the National Petroleum Reserve-Alaska (Reserve) contains some of the world's highest-quality wild lands and waters, including Teshekpuk Lake and the Colville River, both of which are protected as Special Areas under the Reserve's 2012 Integrated Activity Plan. The Bureau of Land Management recently released a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for the Greater Mooses Tooth Unit #1 project that could result in the first commercial production of oil from federal lands in the Reserve since the finalization of the 2012 area-wide plan. Your agency must ensure that any approval of this project results in the smallest possible environmental footprint, minimizes cumulative impacts of this and future development within the Reserve, and that protective measures are put in place for the surrounding communities, wildlife, and the Teshekpuk Lake and Colville River Special Areas within close proximity to the development. Please work to improve the Greater Mooses Tooth Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement.
