A Year to Remember...

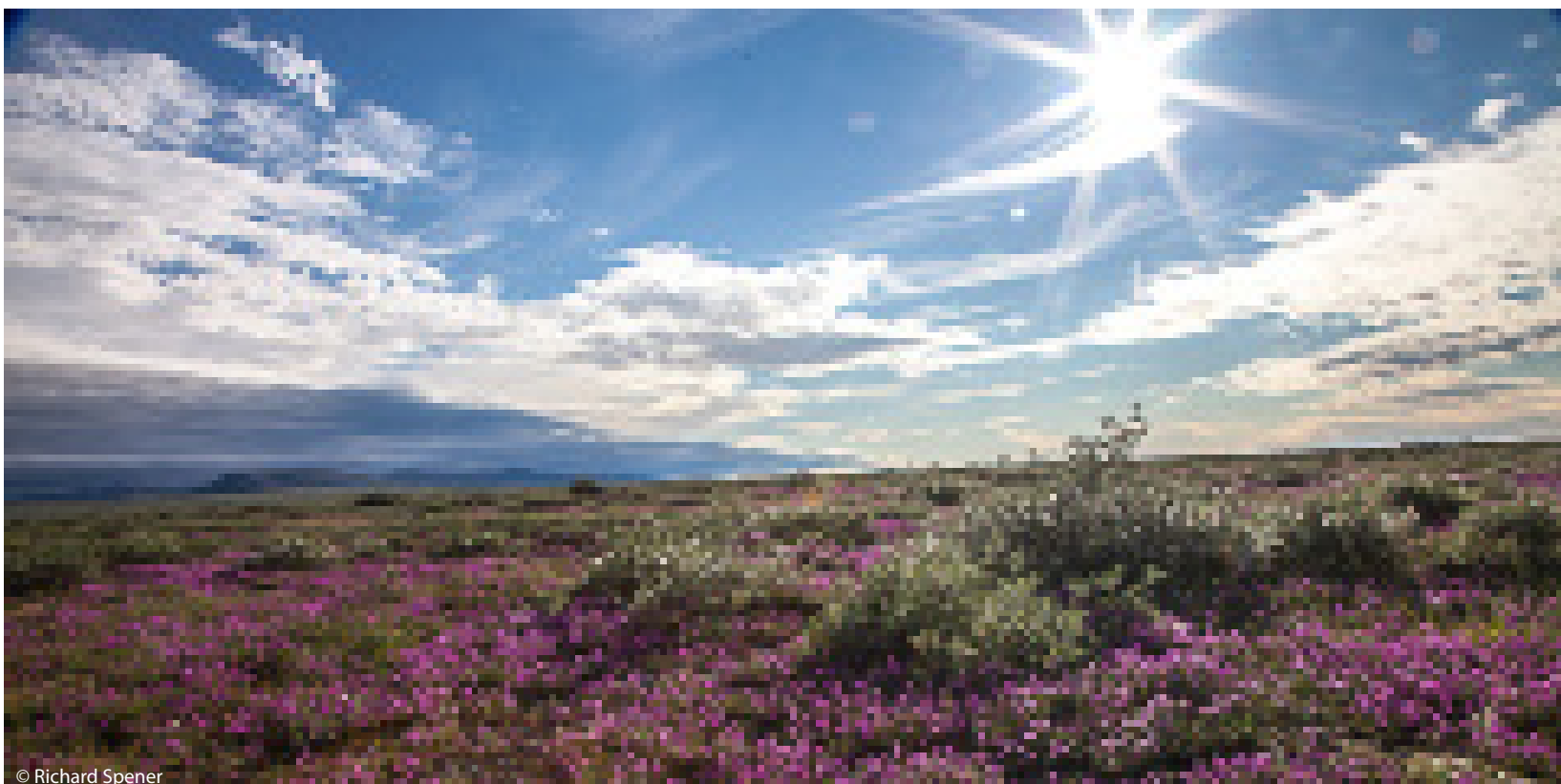

However, it's also the year that brought historic support for the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, bold action to protect the Arctic Ocean, a strong collaborative network for a sustainable Tongass National Forest – and so much more.

Together, we made 2016 a year to remember for Alaska's wild places, while building a vital bulwark of support that will sustain us through the challenges in the years ahead.

In early 2016, we made history with

a first-ever vote in the House of Representatives to proactively protect the Arctic Refuge. We topped that with momentous support in the Senate – 37 senators lined up to co-sponsor the Arctic Refuge Wilderness bill. All of this was possible due to the groundswell of grassroots action – thousands sent petitions, made phone calls and more.

We built on this momentum with unbelievable progress in our fight to protect the Arctic. Incredible actions that included a passionate rally in the heart of our nation's capital, a remarkable visit from the tribal council for Point Lay, Alaska who came out strong for their

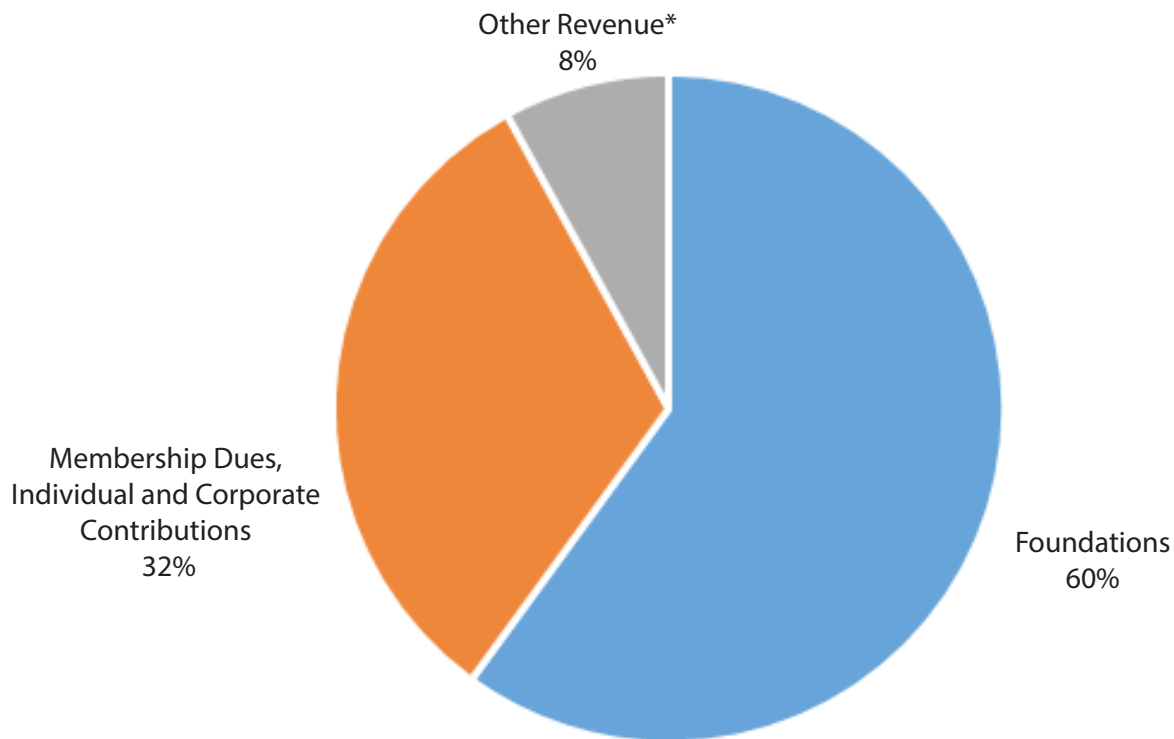

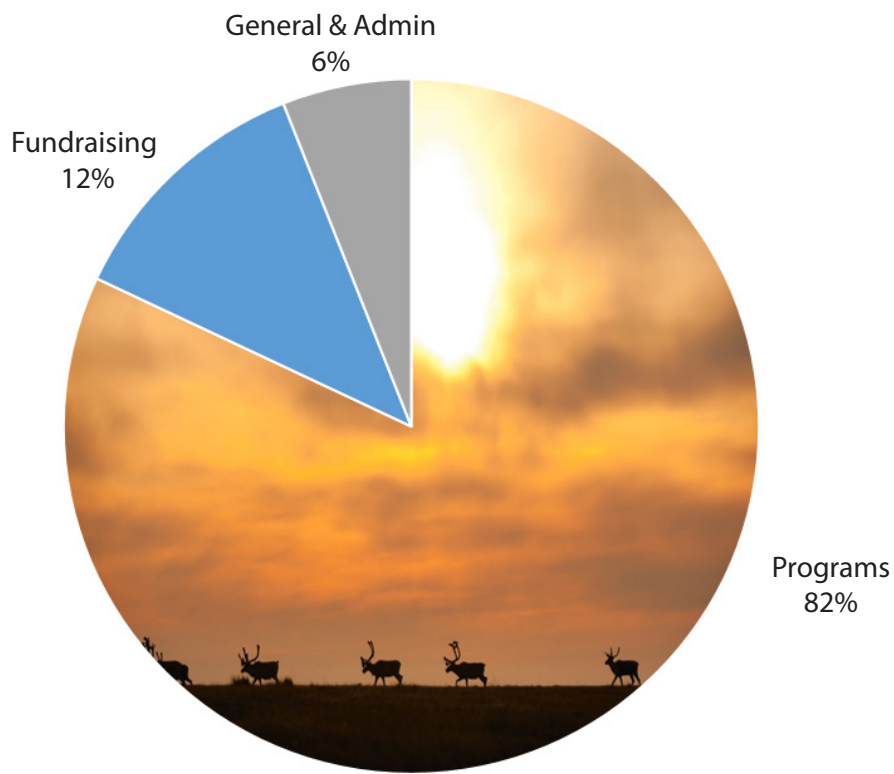

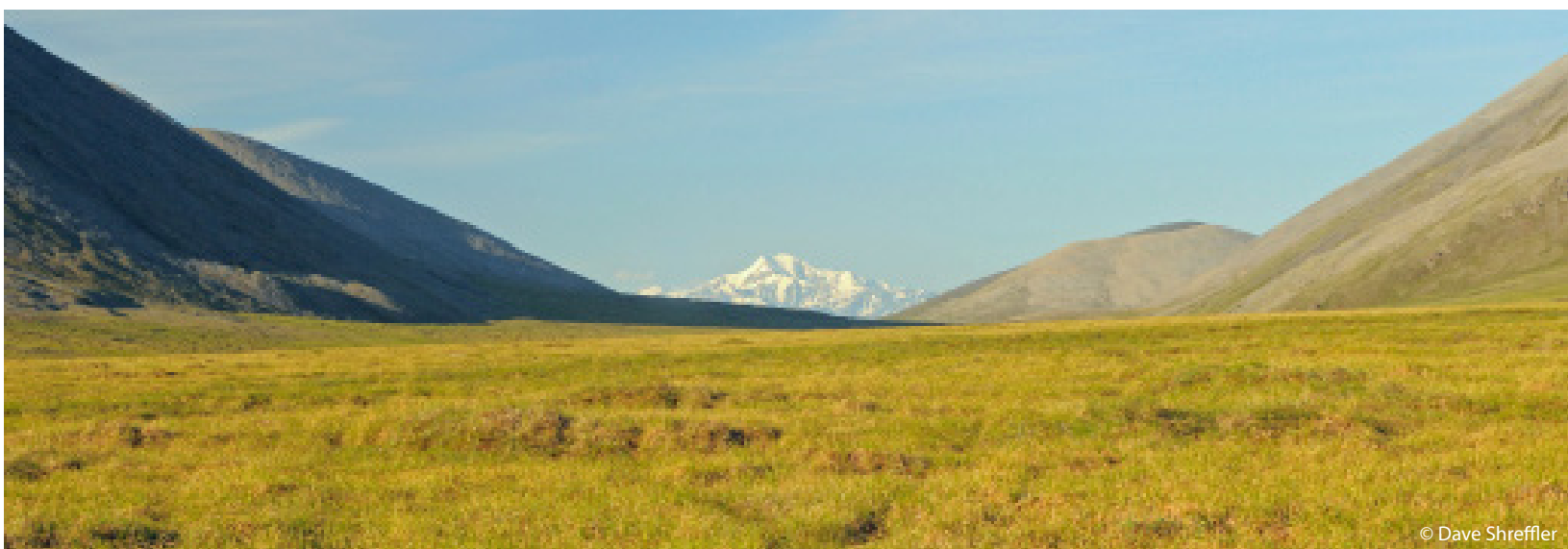


2016 Expenses
